COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Hunter's Hill Council is reviewing the Plan of Management for Boronia Park which will guide the future use and management of the reserve.

Council has engaged Thompson Berrill Landscape Design Pty Ltd to review the Plan.

A key element of the Plan of Management will be understanding community aspirations for the reserve. Council wants to hear from the community about how the reserve should be used now and what should be done to ensure its value is maintained into the future.
